

## Information Posted By Aim (Accelerating Indiana Municipalities) regarding public meetings

Friday's [Ex Order 20-26](#) did not change [Ex Order 20-25](#) which continued virtual meetings for local governments during the public health emergency until **June 4, 2020** or unless extended by the Governor by a future order. Also see, [Ex Order 20-09](#) (issued March 23, 2020).

PAC Britt said that his office is taking phone calls with questions regarding what is “essential business” on a case by case basis. The Governor’s staff took under advisement what would happen if a virtual meeting was scheduled and the public health emergency orders expire at or before the meeting. Aim will be following up on this as well.
